

Call for Poster Abstracts

3rd Annual Faculty Development Workshop

Best Practices for Planning and Evaluation of Experiential Education

Participants of the workshop are invited to share information regarding one or more elements of their school's experiential program via a poster presentation(s). All posters will be displayed throughout the Faculty Development Workshop. No formal presentation will be required, but participants will be able to review posters and network with other participants throughout the program, mainly during breaks. We believe that the poster session will be idea generating and help to identify collaboration opportunities between institutions.

The March 4/5 Faculty Development Program theme will be “**Best Practices for Planning and Evaluation of Experiential Education**”. Schools are encouraged to consider one of the four subcategories below for their poster submissions. Each poster should focus on one them only, but schools can present multiple posters, each addressing a different theme.

1. **Design / Structure of Experiential Program**

How are your introductory & advanced pharmacy practice experiences integrated with other courses within your curriculum? What are core requirements (i.e., skills, activities) of your practice experiences?

2. **Preparation and Readiness of Students**

How do you prepare students for their practice experiences (i.e., orientation programs)? How do you ensure students are ready for practice-based experiential learning?

3. **Recruitment, Training, and Development Strategies for Preceptors and Practice Sites**

How do you recruit preceptors/sites to help deliver your practice experiences? How do you provide training to preceptors to prepare them for teaching students in the clinical setting? What do you offer for ongoing development of preceptors and practice sites?

4. **Experiential Program - Quality Assurance / Improvement Strategies**

How do you assess the overall success of your experiential program (consider any element of program – staff, students, curriculum, or preceptors)? What strategic planning initiatives have you employed within your experiential program?

5. **Other** – Please feel free to address any other experiential-related topic that you feel is important but does not fit in one of the above four categories.

Schools of pharmacy are invited to submit poster abstract(s) to international@acpe-accredit.org by **February 1, 2018**. The abstracts should contain no more than 250 words and should briefly describe the components of your poster. Abstracts can be submitted in either word (.doc) or (pdf) formats. All abstracts should include a title, list one of the above sub-categories that will be addressed, followed by your description. There are no other specific requirements regarding abstract formatting. **All abstracts will be accepted.** Abstracts will be posted on the workshop website to enable participants to review abstracts before the workshop.

A final draft of your poster(s) should be submitted to international@acpe-accredit.org by **February 18, 2018**.

School posters will be displayed on both days at the 3rd Annual Faculty Development Program (2018) at Al Ain University of Science and Technology in Abu Dhabi, UAE. Each poster should be **no larger than 90 cm wide by 150 cm high** (vertical/portrait format).
