The presentation should be aligned with the main themes of this workshop, including the use of technology to enhance assessment of student learning. One school will present on Day 1 and two on Day 2 of the workshop.

We invite your school to submit an abstract to be considered for one of the regional mini-presentations.

The total combined **word count must not exceed 300 words** (excluding title and authors).

Only the submitting author will receive notification of acceptance or rejection after the review process is completed (December 12, 2022). It is the responsibility of the submitting author to communicate this decision to any co-authors. The presenting

author must be registered for the workshop before December 20, 2022, and a draft presentation submitted by January 5, 2023, for the presentation to be confirmed.

Presentations

Accepted abstracts will be presented on either January 16 or 17, 2023. There will be a 20-minute presentation with 10 minutes for Q&A. A PowerPoint template will be provided for the presentations and the workshop organizers reserve the right to limit the number of slides in the presentation. The recommended number of slides (excluding the title slide) is ± 15 .
